#### Pharmacy Robbery & Awareness Training

**Speaker 1: Allen R. Sondej, Esq.** Allen is a Lieutenant with the South Brunswick, NJ Police Department. He has been with the department for over 24 years. He is also a practicing Attorney at Law as well as an Adjunct Professor in the National Security program at New Jersey City University, Jersey City, NJ and a partner at Asymmetric Associates.

#### Current Trends in Third Party Audits

**Speaker 2: Melissa Wood, PharmD., Co-owner, Milly's Pharmacy, Camden, NJ.** Melissa is a co-owner of an independent pharmacy for the past 3 years. Prior to that, she was a District Manager with Rite Aid, overseeing 26 stores in southern NJ. She is also a Certified Immunizing Pharmacist and was responsible for development of MTM, Immunization and Diabetes Clinical Specialist programs at Rite Aid. Melissa is also an Adjunct Professor at Thomas Jefferson School of Pharmacy.
